John B. Drake 8th Grade Contract

- Complete all assignments daily
- Be an active participant in each class each day
- Be respectful of yourself, classmates, school personnel, and school property
- Know and follow school rules and procedures
- Meet the promotion criteria for District-Wide Assessments in all areas
- Earn a final report card grade of "C" or better in all subjects, including Math, Science, Reading, Physical Education/Health, Art, Music, Social Studies, and Writing
- Maintain regular attendance, and not have more than NINE (9) days of unexcused absences
- Follow the school dress code policy
- Not have three or more after-school detentions for the quarter
- Not have one or more days of suspension for the quarter

PRIVILEGEDGES/8TH GRADE ACTIVITIES:

- Spirit Week
- Ribbon Pinning Ceremony
- 8th Grade Trip (TBD)
- Luncheon
- Graduation Ceremony

Failure to meet academic or testing requirements established by Chicago Public Schools that result in summer school attendance would prohibit students' participation in Drake's graduation ceremony. However, students are offered a summer school graduation upon successful completion of the summer school program.

VIOLATING THE 8TH GRADE CONTRACT

All 8th-grade students start the year with the opportunity to attend all 8th-grade activities, including Ribbon Pinning/Passing the Torch, Luncheon, the 8th Grade Trip, and Graduation.

Students will lose one activity if they receive three or more after-school detentions OR 1 suspension PER QUARTER; however, all final decisions will be at the discretion of the principal.

Below is the order in which a student will lose privileges:

1st - Ribbon Pinning/Passing of the Torch

2nd - 8th Grade Trip

3rd - Luncheon

4th - Graduation

This method of earning 8th-grade activities throughout the school year allows the student to take ownership, work hard, and focus each quarter on specific goals for approximately 10-week increments. Parents can encourage their child(ren) to stay focused and abide by school rules and regulations to meet the quarterly expectations.

The 8th-grade team will meet quarterly to review and track each student's eligibility in accordance with the 8th-grade Contract. A list will be generated and posted each quarter for students to track their progress.

Detentions will be issued for the following reasons, but are not limited to this list:

- *Physical Unwarranted contact
- *Roughhousing/making excessive noise
- *Running/making excessive noise
- *Cheating on test
- *Sleeping/Inattentive/Off task
- *Fighting/No Injuries
- *Leaving the classroom without permission

- *Inappropriate touching of another student
- *Defiance/Noncompliance
- *Disrupting classroom/school activities
- *Mocking the teacher/ Bullying Peers
- *Vulgar Language/Profanity
- *Dress code Violation/Out of Uniform
- *Cutting class

Participation in the graduation ceremony and other 8th Grade-related activities is a privilege, not a right.

I understand that if I choose not to participate in these	e activities or am unable to, I am still responsible	for
signing this contract and attending school daily.		

Failure to sign and return this contract will result in exemption from the 8th-grade activities listed above. A copy of this contract will remain on file at John B. Drake Elementary School, and a copy will be sent home for reference.
